

St Paul Apostle South Primary Child Safe Child Friendly Policy



Rationale

At St Paul Apostle South P.S:

- All students enrolled have the right to feel and be safe. The wellbeing of children in our care will always be our first priority and we have zero tolerance to child abuse.
- It is the role of all staff to create a child safe and child friendly environment where children feel safe and are free to enjoy life to the full without any impediments for their safety.
- All staff are mandated to report any type of abuse that is either suspected or disclosed. The school follows set procedures
 in making a report with the safety of each child at the forefront. will be made available from the commencement of the
 school year.

Introduction

This policy communicates to staff, volunteers and students on how to behave with children in our organisation and how we can promote children's participation in our school and make it safer for them.

Support children's participation

St Paul Apostle South P.S. supports the children in our school to join in. Staff listen to children's views, respect what they say and involve them when we make decisions, especially about matters that will affect them. All classes operate Circle Time in our classrooms to talk about things that affect us.

- Will carefully choose people who want to work here using interviews, references and the Working with Children Check.

- We will explain this policy to staff, volunteers and students at the start of each year.
- We will explain this policy to all new staff, volunteers and students.
- All parents, volunteers and staff need to sign the Code of Conduct.
